**AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 3, "TRAFFIC REGULATIONS"
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
TOWN OF BARABOO, SAUK COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Town Board of the Town of Baraboo, Sauk County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority, under Sec. 323.14(4)(a) and Sec. 349.13 of the Wis. Stats., to adopt this amendment to the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Baraboo.

This amendment to the Code of Ordinances, adopted by a majority vote of the Town Board on a roll call vote, with a quorum present and voting, and proper notice having been given, amends Chapter 3, "Traffic Regulations" by adding as follows:

SECTION 3.04 PROHIBITED PARKING ALONG DESIGNATED TOWN ROADWAYS

A. PROHIBITED PARKING

Under the authority of Sec. 349.13(1e) of the Wis. Stats., parking along both sides of the roads designated in Sub. B. below is strictly prohibited, except for the designated pull-out areas intended for parking and clearly marked by official traffic signs, and the exceptions specified in Sec. 346.50 and Sec. 349.13(1k)(a) of the Wis. Stats.

C. SIGNS

Official traffic signs notifying motorists of the prohibition of parking shall be erected and maintained by the Town Patrolman along the appropriate roads listed in Sub. B.

D. ENFORCEMENT

The Sauk County Sheriff's Department and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources' Wardens are delegated the authority to enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3.05 ROAD CLOSURES IN DEVIL'S LAKE STATE PARK

A. ROAD CLOSURES DURING PEAK TIMES

Under the authority of Sec. 323.14(4)(a) of the Wis. Stats., Wis. DNR Wardens are granted permission to prohibit vehicular access, as deemed necessary during peak Devil's Lake State Park visitation, to the following roadways, in order for emergency vehicles to keep safe access to the park: South Shore Road, starting at the intersection of South Shore Road and Ski Hi Road; South Lake Road, starting at the Town Lines; and Park Road (North Shore Road), starting at both the entrance and exit intersections with County Road DL. Exceptions shall be granted to persons with residences on the affected roadways.

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Town Board of the Town of Baraboo, after posting and publication as required by law.
