WHAT'S HAPPENING IN TAPPAHANNOCK?



- The Town finally received a notice of award for its Boating Infrastructure Grant at Hoskins Creek. Now the Town can proceed with permitting and design. These expenses will become eligible for reimbursement through the grant. This is great news.
- The Town needs to continue to build its tourism program with Central Park's construction close to completion. This new asset will be a great attraction for tourists. Staff is working to schedule more photo shoots later this spring in anticipation of the park being completed, along with highlighting other attractions in Town.
- The Town is very close to finalizing its Comprehensive Plan update. The Town Council and Planning Commission intend to hold a joint public hearing at the May 22nd Council meeting. A copy of this will be available online for inspection.

We are excited to announce that our brand new playground and splash pad will be opening in early June! The playground features elements for all ages, even adults!
