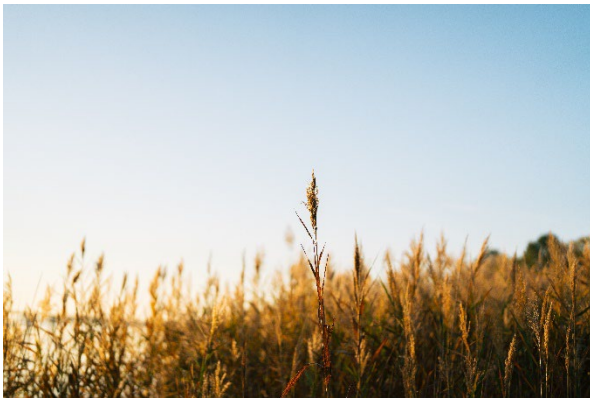

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

Would you like to have your utility bill auto-deducted from your bank account? Well, we have good news regarding just that!

Please visit [online@edmundsgovpay.com/Tappahannock](https://online@edmundsgovpay.com/Tappahannock) if you would like to set up this payment option for your utility account. At this time, we can only accept debit/credit cards through this module.

Select “**New Users: Click Here to Register**” and follow the prompts. Please also contact the town office to ensure your email address is on your utility account.

Once your account is setup, you will receive an email notification prior to the payment being processed. Expect this to occur a week before the bill is due.

The email will contain the payment date, payment amount, fee and confirmation number. Scheduled payments may be canceled through your login account or by contacting the town office. If you have questions, please give us a call.

Contact Virginia 811 before you start your project. Allow required time for marking. Respect and protect the marks. Excavate carefully.
