## Central Park Phase II progress

Recent work includes digging and pouring the exterior and interior footers for the restroom building, as well as the concrete for both pavilions. The mason has completed two perimeter courses of block, and rebar has been installed in the pavilion pillars. Metal plates for the pavilions have been received, and the first segment of the sidewalk has been formed. The framing crew is scheduled to begin work on August 18.

## Never Miss a Payment Again — Sign Up for Auto-Pay!

Want your utility bill charged automatically to your debit or credit card? Great news — you can now set this up online!

Select “**New Users: Click Here to Register**” and follow the prompts. Please also contact the town office to ensure your email address is on your utility account.

Once your account is set up, you will receive an email notification prior to the payment being processed. Expect this to occur a week before the bill is due.

The email will contain the payment date, payment amount, fee, and confirmation number. Scheduled payments may be canceled through your login account or by contacting the town office. If you have questions, please give us a call.
