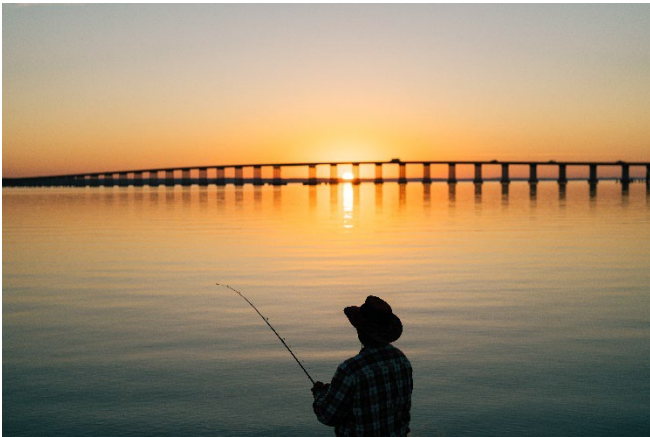

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN TAPPAHANNOCK?



- While Central Park construction is set to wrap up this summer, staff is working on the design of multiple pavilion areas for seating and a permanent restroom, set to be constructed in the spring of 2025.
- For the Downtown Sewer Project, night work on Queen Street wrapped up before Memorial Day Weekend. The contractors are currently working on Duke Street. A final paving of all roads affected by the project is scheduled to happen this fall.

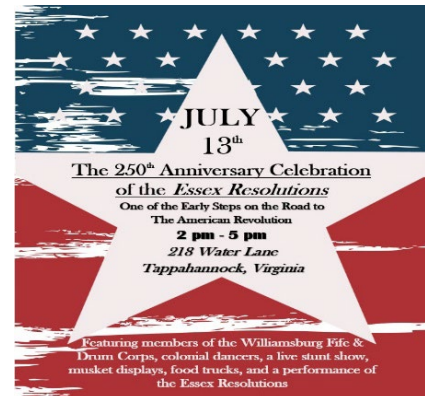
MEET TAPPAHANNOCK'S NEW CHIEF OF POLICE



A City of Petersburg police captain has been named the next Chief of Police for the Town of Tappahannock. Council has appointed Thomas Carter to the role. Carter is presently the Operations Captain at the Petersburg Bureau of Police (PBP). Born in Danville, Virginia, he later moved to Chesterfield County, Virginia. He joined PBP in 2010, as a patrolman. Over the years, he has risen through the ranks, serving as the Operations Services Division Commander. PAYMENT OPTIONS

Would you like to have your utility bill auto-deducted from your bank account? Well, we have good news regarding just that!

Please visit online@edmundsgovpay.com/Tappahannock if you would like to set up this payment option for your utility account.

Select “**New Users: Click Here to Register**” and follow the prompts. Please also contact the town office to ensure your email address is on your utility account.

Once your account is setup, you will receive an email notification prior to the payment being processed. Expect this to occur a week before the bill is due.

The email will contain the payment date, payment amount, fee and confirmation number. Scheduled payments may be canceled through your login account or by contacting the town office. If you have questions, please give us a call.

Contact Virginia 811 before you start your project. Allow required time for marking. Respect and protect the marks. Excavate carefully.
