What's Happening in Tappahannock?

Central Park Phase II is set to begin in early July, bringing exciting new features and improvements to enhance the park experience for residents and visitors. This phase will include the addition of two 16x20 ft pavilions, new restroom facilities, and the conversion of existing stone pavings into smooth concrete pathways for better accessibility. We're also exploring the possibility of adding a third pavilion to provide additional shade near the playground area. The project is expected to be completed by the end of January 2026. Throughout construction, we plan to keep the playground and splash pad open to the public as much as possible. Should any closures be necessary, they will be brief
