REAL ESTATE TAX REMINDER

Real Estate tax bills were mailed out on Friday, 10/4/2024 and are due on 12/5/24. If you own real estate in the Town of Tappahannock, you will receive a real estate tax bill from the Town of Tappahannock. You may mail your payment, drop it in the office Dropbox, call the office, or pay online at <https://wipp.edmundsassoc.com/Wipp/?wippid=TAPP>. If your mortgage lender is responsible for paying your real estate taxes, you will not receive a bill. PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX REMINDER

Personal Property tax bills were mailed the week of 10/21/24 and are due on 12/5/24. All personal property, owned on 1/1/24, that has a garage jurisdiction of the Town of Tappahannock with DMV/DWR, is taxed in 2024 by the Town of Tappahannock. The Town does not prorate. PAYMENT OPTIONS

Would you like to have your utility bill auto-deducted from your bank account? Well, we have good news regarding just that!

Please visit online@edmundsgovpay.com/Tappahannock if you would like to set up this payment option for your utility account. At this time, we can only accept debit/credit cards through this module.

Select “**New Users: Click Here to Register**” and follow the prompts. Please also contact the town office to ensure your email address is on your utility account.

Once your account is set up, you will receive an email notification prior to the payment being processed. Expect this to occur a week before the bill is due.

The email will contain the payment date, payment amount, fee, and confirmation number. Scheduled payments may be canceled through your login account or by contacting the town office. If you have questions, please give us a call.
