Central Park Phase II progress

Progress continues on Central Park Phase II. Since the last update, the framing for the restroom building and pavilions has been completed, and the structures are beginning to take shape. Roofing has been installed on both pavilions, and additional sidewalk sections have been poured, further defining the layout of the park. Crews are now focused on masonry and interior work on the restroom building, as well as grading and site preparation for the next phase of improvements. The project remains on track, bringing us one step closer to an expanded community space for all to enjoy.



Real Estate Tax Reminder

Real Estate tax bills were mailed out on Tuesday, 10/14/2025 and are due on 12/5/25. If you own real estate in the Town of Tappahannock, you will receive a real estate tax bill from the Town of Tappahannock. You may mail your payment, call the office or pay on-line at <https://wipp.edmundsassoc.com/Wipp/?wippid=TAPP>. If your mortgage lender is responsible for paying your real estate taxes, you will not receive a bill. Personal Property Tax Reminder

Personal Property tax bills were mailed out on Tuesday, 10/14/25 and are due on 12/5/25. All personal property, owned on 1/1/25, that has a garage jurisdiction of the Town of Tappahannock with DMV/DWR, is taxed in 2025 by the Town of Tappahannock. The Town does not prorate. You may mail your payment, drop it off in the Town Drop-Box or call the office.

Want your utility bill charged automatically to your debit or credit card? Great news — you can now set this up online!

Select **“New Users: Click Here to Register”** and follow the prompts. Please also contact the town office to ensure your email address is on your utility account.

Once your account is set up, you will receive an email notification prior to the payment being processed. Expect this to occur a week before the bill is due.

The email will contain the payment date, payment amount, fee, and confirmation number. Scheduled payments may be canceled through your login account or by contacting the town office. If you have questions, please give us a call.
