WATER & SEWER SERVICES

December 15 – February 14
Due: March 30th

February 15 – April 14
Due: May 30th

April – 15 – June 14
Due: July 30th

June 15 – August 14
Due: September 30th

August 15 – October 14
Due: November 30th

October 15 – December 14
Due: January 30th



TRASH PICKUP

Residential Trash is picked up on
Tuesdays and Fridays.
Commercial Trash is picked up on
Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday.

Rate: Residential	\$40.00
Commercial	\$80.00
Dumpster	\$140.00

Please put your trash out before
8AM (or 6AM June - August) on the
day of pickup. If you are a Town of
Tappahannock resident and do not
have a dumpster at your apartment
complex, then trash must be put
inside a bag and the bag placed in a
trash container no larger than a 33-
gallon can with a lid (to keep critters
out). The Town DOES NOT provide a
trash can.

RECYCLE PROGRAM: Recyclable
items are picked up every Thursday.
This is a free program, and bins are
provided by this office. Only one bin
per household.

TAXES: REAL ESTATE & PERSONAL PROPERTY

Real Estate Tax

Real estate taxes are assessed by the
Essex County Commissioner of the
Revenue, based on property
valuations as of January 1 each year.

The real estate bills are due and
payable on or before December 5th.
All property owners are mailed copies
of their bills; however, if the property
tax is paid via a third party, the bill
will be mailed to the third party.

Personal Property Tax

Personal property tax on vehicles,
boats, trailers, mobile homes,
business property, etc., are assessed
by the Essex County Commissioner of
the Revenue, based on property
valuations as of January 1 each year.
Personal property that is owned on
January 1st and is garaged in the
Town of Tappahannock, will be billed
to the corresponding owner for the
entire year. If the personal property is
moved into the Town after January
1st, the property will not be billed to
the owner until the following year. All
property owners are mailed copies of
their bills, which are due and payable
on or before December 5th.
