FALL CLEAN UP

- ◆ Leaves **MUST NOT** be swept or blown into the street. This causes damage and clogs our drainage system.
- ◆ Trim trees/bushes on your property that hang into streets or sidewalks—this allows pedestrians, buses, snow plow to go through safely
- ◆ Do **NOT** drain sump pumps into the sewer system

TREE TRIMMING

- ◆ Trim trees/bushes on your property that hang into streets or sidewalks—this allows pedestrians, buses, snow plow to go through safely. Public works will be out trimming those that do not get done.

BRUSH SITE

- ◇ Place yard waste on correct piles
- ◇ Grass Clippings, leaves, Brush smaller than 4 inch in diameter.
- ◇ Please take bags with you.
- ◇ Do not dump other items in compost. This is not a garbage site.

Site closes November 1, weather permitting.

ATTENTION DOG OWNERS:

- ◇ When walking dog, keep them on a leash.
- ◇ Clean up after your dog. (bring bags with you)
- ◇ Dogs barking constantly is **NOT** a sign of a happy dog.

STOP FOR SCHOOL BUSES

School is starting up again soon. Remember to stop for school buses when signals are flashing and stop for pedestrians in cross walks.

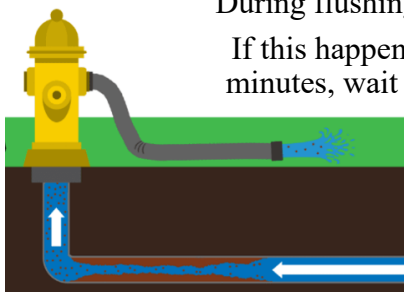

CITY TO FLUSH HYDRANTS

September 30—October 4

WEATHER PERMITTING

Regular hydrant flushing (water main flushing) improves drinking water quality by removing sediments from inside the mainline and flushing them out through the hydrant

During flushing, your water may be discolored.

If this happens run your cold water for 3 or 4 minutes, wait and if still discolored run again.

It is recommended to not wash clothes during this time, as it may discolor your clothes.

WINTER WEATHER IS AROUND THE CORNER

KEEP SIDEWALKS SHOVELED. It is the responsibility of the property owner to shovel the sidewalk after each snow fall. (within 12 hours of snow fall). If it is not completed City will have it done at owners expense.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Remember to keep hydrants free of snow. This is for your safety and your neighbor's safety.

WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS: NOVEMBER 1 – APRIL 1

No parking on any city streets between 2:30 am – 6:00 am.

GARBAGE CONTAINERS: Don't place garbage cans in the street—they belong in the driveway.

Be **AWARE** and **COURTEOUS** of Snowplows and Snow removal equipment with flashing lights. If you are able, help out your neighbor, and thank you to those who already lend a hand!

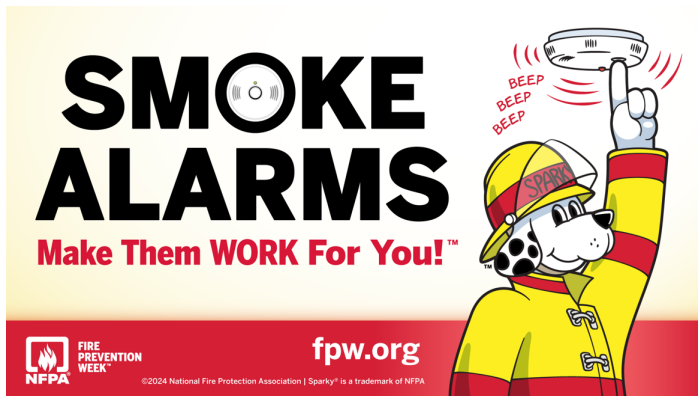

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

OCTOBER 6TH-12TH



The Eden Valley Fire & Rescue department encourages everyone to embrace the theme this year

~Smoke alarms: Make them work for you!~

“Working smoke alarms can make a life-savings difference in a home fire, giving people the time to get out safely. This year’s Fire Prevention Week campaign is a great way to remind everyone to install your smoke alarms and check them monthly,” said Fire Chief Teicher.

Your Fire Department wants to share these key home smoke alarm safety tips and guidelines:

- ◆ Install smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside each separate sleeping area (like a hallway), and on each level (including the basement) of the home.
- ◆ Make sure smoke alarms meet the needs of all family members, including those with sensory or physical disabilities.
- ◆ Test smoke alarms at least once a month by pushing the test button.
- ◆ Replace smoke alarms when they are 10 years old.

BURNING IN THE CITY



Recreational fires:

- ◆ 25 feet away from all buildings of combustible materials
- ◆ Fire must be constantly attended by an adult
- ◆ A 3 foot pit of ring for the fire or above ground fire pit no larger than 36 inches in diameter with a screen
- ◆ A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher or garden hose connected to water source must be available
- ◆ Materials To Burn: Tree Wood, dimensional lumber, small branches, brush or charcoal
- ◆ The fire must be immediately extinguished if they pose a fire safety risk or if they are not in compliance.

BE SMART! Pay attention to the weather.
DO NOT BURN if windy!!!

Open Burning:

- ◆ Permit Required—pick up at City Hall
- ◆ October 1 to November 15th
- ◆ Must follow restrictions set in Ordinance

CHECK YOUR HOUSE NUMBERS!

We hope you never have to call for help but if you do will the responders be able to find your house???

Make sure your house numbers are **clearly visible** from the street. Emergency response vehicles need to be able to see your address.

Keep bushes and trees trimmed if they are blocking your numbers.
