**HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH (NOT HAZARDOUS):** Free if a resident within city limits, \$20 per vehicle for all others

**YARD TRASH:** Free for residents within city limits, \$20 per vehicle for all others.

**TIRES (Car/Truck):** \$25 per tire

**TIRES (Tractor):** \$250 each

**ELECTRONICS:** \$30 per electronic (TVs, Computer monitors, etc.)

**APPLIANCES:** Free (does not include TV's and RV Refrigerators)



## **\*\*\*HYDRANT FLUSHING REMINDER\*\*\***



The city will be flushing the hydrants the week of **May 13th** (weather permitting).

During flushing your water may be discolored. If this happens run your cold water for 3 or 4 minutes, wait and if still discolored run again. It is recommended to not wash clothes during this time, as it may discolor your clothes.

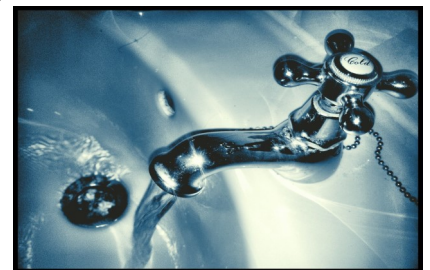
The 2023 Eden Valley's Consumer Confidence Report for Drinking Water will not be published or mailed to individual addresses.

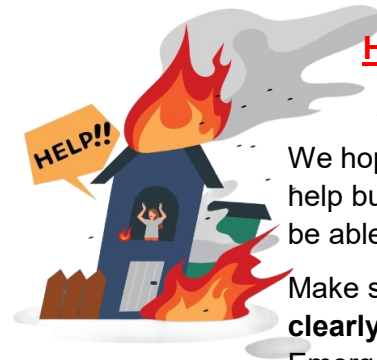




## Who's New in Public Works:

Emergency response vehicles need to be able to see your address.

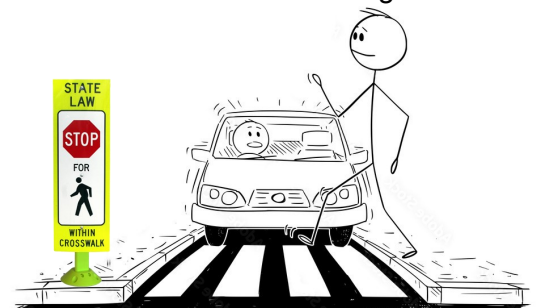
Keep bushes and trees trimmed if they are blocking your numbers.

## STOP AT CROSS WALKS

Down town gets really busy as the weather warms up and after school lets out. **Remember is it the law to stop for pedestrians in the crosswalk.** Slow down and watch for those walking!



## **RECREATIONAL CAMPFIRES:**

are allowed in the city provided:

- ◆ 25 feet away from all buildings of combustible materials
- ◆ Fire must be constantly attended by an adult
- ◆ A 3 foot pit of ring for the fire or above ground fire pit no larger than 36 inches in diameter with a screen
- ◆ A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher or garden hose connected to water source must be available
- ◆ Materials To Burn: Tree Wood, dimensional lumber, small branches, brush or charcoal
- ◆ The fire must be immediately extinguished if they pose a fire safety risk or if they are not in compliance.



**BE SMART!** Pay attention to the weather.

**DO NOT BURN** if windy!!!

## KEEP YARDS MOWED & TREES TRIMMED

City ordinance requires homeowners to keep their yards mowed and free of weeds. Your lawn should be no longer than 6 inches.

Trees and bushes should not block the view at an intersection. Remember to keep them trimmed. Be aware of wires!

If this is not done, the property owner will be notified in writing. If the issue is not resolved by the date given the City will take care of it at the owners expense of \$100.00 per hour for first time with an increase of \$100.00 per hour per additional nuisance.
