EV-W School District #463 Special Election



School District Question

The board of school district No. 463 has proposed to revoke the School District's existing referendum revenue authorization of \$82.75 per pupil and to replace that authorization with a new authorization of \$460 per pupil, subject to an annual increase at the rate of inflation. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be first levied in 2023 for taxes payable in 2024 and applicable for ten (10) years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law.

While many people believe that cats should have access to the outdoors, it's important to keep in mind that there are a number of risks involved with letting your cat outside.


Dangers are, but not limited to:
