Acceptable Items:

****Household Rubbish (NOT Hazardous): Free** disposal if you are a resident within the city limits, \$30 per vehicle for all others. YES, this includes couches and other furniture.

****Yard Trash: Free** for residents within the city limits, \$30 per vehicle for all others (Remember that organic yard waste, leaves and brush, can go to the brush site located north of town by the ponds).

****Tires:** Car/Truck tires are \$25 per tire, Tractor tires are \$250 per tire.

****Electronics:** \$30 per electronic (TVs, computer monitors, etc.).

****Appliances:** FREE (does not include TVs, screens, RV Refrigerators)

ENSURE YOUR HOUSE NUMBER IS VISIBLE

Why it Matters: In an emergency every second counts!
Clearly visible house numbers help first responders locate your home quickly when you need medical, fire, or police assistance.

Make Sure Your House Number Is:

- ✓ Large and Easy to read from the street
- ✓ Well-lit and visible at night
- ✓ Free from obstructions like trees or decorations
- ✓ Place on your house and mailbox for extra visibility

Check your House Numbers Today!

RECREATIONAL CAMPFIRES:

are allowed in the city provided:

- ◆ 25 feet away from all buildings of combustible materials
- ◆ Fire must be constantly attended by an adult
- ◆ A 3 foot pit of ring for the fire or above ground fire pit no larger than 36 inches in diameter with a screen
- ◆ A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher or garden hose connected to water source must be available
- ◆ Materials To Burn: Tree Wood, dimensional lumber, small branches, brush or charcoal
- ◆ The fire must be immediately extinguished if they pose a fire safety risk or if they are not in compliance.



BE SMART! Pay attention to the weather.

DO NOT BURN if windy!!!

- * Get a tag at City hall to help if you loose your dog (no fee)



BRUSH SITE

Perfect place to bring all the clippings from yard work!



- ◆ Only yard and garden waste allowed
- ◆ Brush no larger than 4 inches in diameter
- ◆ Absolutely no garbage!
- ◆ Take your bags with you
- ◆ Open April-October Weather Permitting

- ♦ Meters are read near the 30th of the month
- ♦ Bills are mailed/emailed around the 3rd of the month
- ♦ Save paper – sign up for email billing

Email bills come from a company called Docusend, please add to your contacts to ensure the delivery to your inbox and not your spam/junk.

- ♦ Bills are due monthly, must be received by end of month to avoid 10% late fees.

- ♦ Sign up for Auto Pay –
Monthly amount is deducted on the 25th -
Use savings or checking account.
Fill out and return the application
No processing Fees.
