

TRAFFIC ORDINANCE # 2001 - 2

Section 1: Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the parking, standing and stopping of vehicles within the Township of Land O'Lakes.

Section 2: Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Land O'Lakes has the specific statutory authority, powers and duties, pursuant to the specific statutory sections noted in this ordinance and/or by its adoption of village powers under Sec. 60.10, (1999-2000) Wis. Stats., to regulate, control, prevent and enforce against the Town of Land O'Lakes certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the traffic in the Town of Land O'Lakes.

Section 3: Adoption of Ordinance

The Town Board of the Town of Land O'Lakes has, by adoption of this ordinance, confirmed the specific statutory authority, powers and duties noted in the specific sections of this ordinance and has established, by these sections and this ordinance, the regulations, controls and enforcement against certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the traffic in the Town of Land O'Lakes.

Section 4: General Provisions

A

Except as specifically noted otherwise in this ordinance, in Chapters 340 to 348, (1999-2000) Wis. Stats., inclusive, Chapter 350 and Chapter 941, (1999-2000) Wis. Stats., describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles, traffic and snowmobiles for which the penalty is a forfeiture only, including penalties to be imposed and procedure for prosecution, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference by the Town of Land O'Lakes and made part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Any future amendments, modifications, revisions, additions or deletions of the above noted statutory Chapters shall be incorporated herein and made part of this ordinance in order to secure uniform state regulations of traffic on the public highways, roads, streets and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.

B

The Town of Land O'Lakes establishes by this ordinance, any areas marked by the Town of Land O'Lakes, by traffic signs as "No Parking" areas are such in the Town of Land O'Lakes.

C

No person shall cause, allow or permit any person to operate or maintain a motor bike, motorcycle, mini-bike, ATV, go-cart, trail bike or snowmobile in the Town of Land O'Lakes:

- a) at unreasonable speeds for conditions
- b) in a careless way that endangers persons or property
- c) while under the influence of drugs or alcoholic beverages
- d) without functional headlights
- e) without a functional muffler

D

The Town of Land O'Lakes establishes, by this ordinance, the following as "No Parking at Night" areas in the Town of Land O'Lakes:

As posted on County Highway B from U.S. Highway 45 to Olympic 76 Street

"Night", for the purpose of this section, is defined as being the following hours:
2:00 a.m. - 7:00 a.m.

This restriction applies during the following calendar months:
November 15th - April 1st

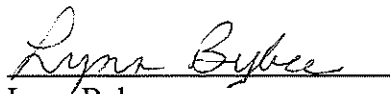
In these areas marked by the Town of Land O'Lakes traffic signs, as noted in Sec. 349.13, (1999-2000) Wis. Stats., no person shall park any vehicle for a period of time longer than sixty (60) minutes between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

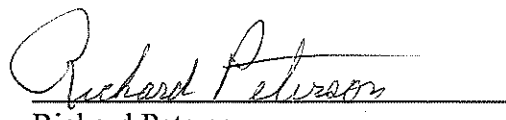
Section 5: School Bus Operators

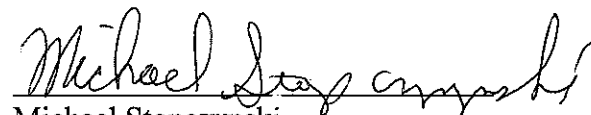
The Town of Land O'Lakes establishes by adoption of this ordinance in conformance with Sec. 346.48(2)(b)2 and pursuant to Sec. 349.21(1) within the Township of Land O'Lakes that school bus operators must use flashing red warning lights when pupils or other authorized passengers are to be loaded or unloaded where a sidewalk and curb are laid on both sides of the road.

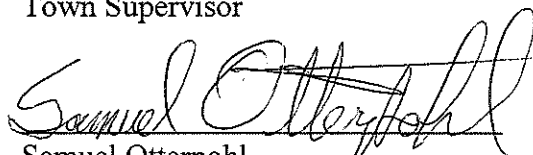
