Universal Waste Sheds~ 7 Locations. Open to ALL 14 member towns. This Recycling Services is for fluorescent light bulbs, rechargeable and Lithium batteries, Thermostats, Thermometers. Please tape the battery terminals and or place each individual battery in a small plastic baggie. This prevents the terminals from making contact.

No Alkaline batteries! Those are to be placed in your household trash. Currently there is NO cost for the residents to utilize this recycling service. This is paid from NBSWMD yearly budget.
