PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTER MEETING NOTICE

WASHINGTON STREET, PARK DRIVE, AND COMMERCE PLACE
STREETSCAPE PROJECT

The Township of Mount Holly will be hosting a Public Information Center to inform local residents, officials, businesses, and the general public of the status of proposed improvements for the Washington Street, Park Drive, And Commerce Place Streetscape Project in the Township of Mount Holly.

This project will incorporate various streetscaping activities including the replacement of severely deteriorated and missing curbing with new vertical concrete curb or concrete monolithic curb and gutter where required to improve drainage. The deteriorated, uneven concrete sidewalk along Washington Street will be replaced with decorative brick paver sidewalk to match the brick paver sidewalks that were installed during Phases I and II along High Street and Commerce Place. The replacement of the concrete sidewalk with brick paver sidewalk would provide a unified and attractive appearance for the sidewalks in the Mount Holly downtown area. The replacement of the deteriorated, uneven concrete sidewalk along Park Drive and Commerce Place with 6-foot wide concrete sidewalk will enhance pedestrian safety and provide better access to the potential community/green space. Replacement of concrete driveway aprons as well as ADA curb ramps that do meet current ADA slope requirements will provide safer access to individuals with disabilities. Construction of a concrete retaining wall and aluminum railing to replace the failing retaining wall along the sidewalk on Park Drive will enhance public safety. The installation of thermoplastic traffic striping at crosswalks will enhance visibility of the crosswalks. The installation of a solar powered, rectangular rapid flashing beacon pedestrian crosswalk system at the crosswalk between the Township Municipal Building and the U.S. Post Office on Washington Street and the replacement of traffic signs with signs conforming to the MUTCD will enhance vehicular and pedestrian safety. The improvements will bring the area into full compliance with ADA standards. In addition, street trees that are more suitable for streetscapes will be planted in place of the existing trees that have caused dislocation of the sidewalk resulting in an unsafe walking surface. The streetlights will be replaced with the same decorative style streetlights that were used in Phase II along High Street and Commerce Place.

The proposed project will provide residents and visitors with improved surface transportation opportunities by enhancing pedestrian facilities in the downtown area, including improving connections to public facilities and local transit services. The proposed project focuses specifically on promoting pedestrianism as a preferred method of travel to access key destinations within the Township's downtown. It is for all the reasons listed above that the Mount Holly Township Streetscape Project will have a positive impact on improving surface transportation for non-motorized uses.
