The Sister Bay Water and Sewer Utility operates under the "Standard Small Utility Rules" published by the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin. The above water rates were approved by the Public Service Commission on January 22, 2018, and effective January 23, 2018. The sewer rates were approved by the Sister Bay Village Board on February 21, 2018, effective October 1, 2018 provided the Well No. 1 & Lift Station No. 1 Modification Project has been completed.

Bills for water service are rendered quarterly and become due and payable upon issuance following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of 3% but not less than 50¢ for both water and sewer will be added to bills not paid within 20 days of issuance. The one-time 3% late payment charge will be applied only to any unpaid balance for the current billing period's usage. This late payment charge is applicable to all customers. The utility customer may be given written notice that the bill is overdue no sooner than 20 days after the bill is issued and unless payment is made within the next 10 days, service may be disconnected pursuant to Chapter PSC 185, Wis. Adm. Code.
