AN ORDINANCE LIMITING PARKING ALONG STATE HIGHWAY 57

WHEREAS, parking along certain portions of State Highway 57 have resulted in congestion and posed a safety hazard to the traveling public; and,

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation allows a village to designate certain areas of the highway as not being available for parking, provided the Municipal Code has designated the area as a no parking zone, and the village takes responsibility for posting the area as not being available for parking; and,

WHEREAS, at the April 8, 2024, meeting of the Village of Sister Bay Parks, Property and Streets Committee, the Committee unanimously decided to recommend to the Village Board an amendment to Chapter 58, *Traffic and Vehicles*, that portion of State Highway 57, beginning at the southern incorporated boundary of the Village of Sister Bay, north along State Highway 57 a distance of 1500', be designated as a no parking area on both the east and west side of the highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Sister Bay does hereby amend Chapter 58, Article 3, of the Municipal Code to establish a no parking area along State Highway 57 as shown below.

SECTION 1. Adoption of Code Amendments. Amend Secs. 58.61 and 58.66 of the Village of Sister Bay Municipal Code, Chapter 58, *Traffic and Vehicles*, Article 3, *Parking*, as shown in red below (for ease of reading a strikethrough represents a deletion and an underscore represents an addition).

Sec. 58.61 Purpose; statutory authority.

- Pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 61.34(1), the village board restricts parking in the various village parking lots as identified below:
 - (1) Marina Long term parking lot located between Sunset Drive and Scandia Road, east of Bay Shore Drive at 2279 Scandia Road.
 - (2) Marina parking lot located at the Marina at 10733 North Bay Shore Drive
 - (3) Long Term Marina parking located at 2125 Autumn Court Drive.
 - (4) Post Office Parking lot located behind the Post Office at 10685 North Bay Shore Drive.
 - (5) Boathouse parking located at 10697 North Bay Shore Drive.
 - (6) Waterfront Park South parking lots located on both sides of Mill Road located at 2362 Mill Road.
 - (7) Sports Complex parking lot located at 2155 Autumn Court Drive.
 - (8) Any municipally owned parking lot installed after the adoption of this Section. [Ord 312]
- Pursuant to Wis. Stats. §61.34(1), the Village Board finds it necessary for the safety of its residents, proper maintenance of its roads, to reduce congestion, and to prevent blight, to regulate overnight parking on Village streets or those the Village is responsible for

maintaining, and, to prohibit parking along certain local streets or state highways. [Ord 312]

Sec. 58.66 Regulation of parking on Highway 42, Highway 57, and Village Streets. [Ord 312]

- (a) <u>Purpose.</u> Pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 61.34(1) and 349.13(1), the purpose of this section is to prohibit certain parking at any time in a certain area on State Highway 42, also known as North Bay Shore Drive, <u>State Highway 57</u>, and prohibit long-term overnight parking on South Bay Shore Drive and on all Village streets, <u>in-</u>in order to reduce traffic congestion throughout the village, and to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the Village residents.
- (b) <u>Definitions.</u> All of the definitions in Wis. Stats. § 340.01, as amended, are adopted by reference in this section.
 - (1) 'Overnight' shall mean the period of time in which parking is prohibited on a public street, and for purposes of this Chapter shall mean the period of time between the hours of 2:00 AM and 7:00 AM.
 - (c) Prohibited parking.

- (1) No person shall park, or suffer to be parked, at any time any boat trailer, motor home, mobile home, camping trailer, or other motor vehicle in excess of 22 feet in length on State Highway 42, also known as Bay Shore Drive, or on any public street in the Village of Sister Bay.
- (2) Except as provided for below, no motor vehicle, including trailers, shall be parked overnight on North Bay Shore Dr.
- (3) Except for safety reasons, overnight parking is prohibited on South Bay Shore Drive or on any Village street. If a vehicle has been parked overnight, the owner shall receive a written warning; if the vehicle is still parked on the street a second night, a citation shall be issued.
- (4) There shall be no parking along State Highway 57 from the south boundary of the Village municipal limits, north a distance of 1500' parallel to the highway, on both the east and west side of said highway.
- (d) <u>Exceptions.</u> The exceptions provided by Wis. Stats. § 346.50, as amended, are incorporated by reference in this section.
- (e) <u>Penalties.</u>
 - (1) Any person violating this section may be required to forfeit a penalty per the most recent fee schedule adopted by resolution by the Village Board. not less than \$50 for the first offense and not less than \$75 for the second or subsequent offense within one year.
 - (2) A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.
- (f) <u>Enforcement.</u>
 - (1) This section may be enforced by the issuance of a citation to any violator of this section by any sheriff or deputy sheriff of the county, by any state officer with police powers or any other duly appointed law enforcement officer or designee of the village.
