Upcoming Deadlines

Foreclosures: Property taxes with a past-due balance for the tax year 2022-2023 will foreclose on January 6th, 2025. Payments after December 1st need to be paid in full by cash or bank check.

Boat Registrations: Expires in December; renew at the town office or online through MOSES

Dog License: Register or renew your dog license for 2025 starting October 15th. Renew online or at the town office before January 31st to avoid late fees.
