PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS ON RIDGEWOOD CIRCLE

The Town Board of the Town of Plover, Portage County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under Wis. Stat. §349.07 (8), to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote, with a quorum present, and proper notice having been given, provides for the installation of stop signs on town highways in the Town of Plover as follows:

Stop signs shall be placed on Ridgewood Circle at each entrance of that road onto Ridgewood Drive.

The Town Highway Superintendent, or designee, shall erect said stop signs as provided in this ordinance on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under Wis. Stat. §60.80

This Ordinance shall be effective on July 8, 2022.
