Resolution to Amend 2022 Budget of the Town of Plover

The Town Board of the Town of Plover, Portage County, State of Wisconsin hereby resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, this resolution to amend the Town of Plover 2022 budget must be adopted by a two-thirds majority vote of the entire membership of the Town of Plover Town Board, and

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 contains provisions for the direct allocation of federal funds to America's local governments as part of the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) Program to be used no later than December 31,2024, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Plover's direct allocation is \$173,959, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Plover has established and maintained a special revenue fund specifically for the purposes of the SLFRF Program which had not previously been applied to the Town of Plover annual budget but is now essential to fund a critical need within the township, and

WHEREAS, the Plover Town Board has designated the use of the entire fund plus interest earned in the sum of \$174,839.78 for the resurfacing of 2.07 miles of Biron Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Plover Town Board does hereby authorize the following amendments to the 2022 budget:
