STATE OF WISCONSIN TOWN OF PLOVER PORTAGE COUNTY

The Town Board of the Town of Plover, Portage County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 66.60(16), to ordain as follows: this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present, voting and proper notice having been given, supersedes Ordinance 110498 in the regulation of snow removal and parking on town roads as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 66.60(16), Wis. Stats., effective upon passage and publication, the town board does ordain as follows
  - 1. From November 1<sup>st</sup> thru March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year, there shall be no parking of any vehicles on town roads or on the right of way of a town road during snow days.
  - 2. During the snow season, no person shall deposit or cause to be deposited snow or ice taken or removed from a premise, residence or property onto any public place, street or road in the Town of Plover. The property owner who violates this ordinance will receive one warning; subsequent offenses will result in vehicle being towed at the owner's expense.
  - 3. Any vehicle on a town road needing assistance due to driver negligence will be towed at owner's expense. Additional costs may be experienced if "after hours" expenses are incurred by the municipality to facilitate access for an emergency vehicle or a tow truck.
  - 4. Failure to pay this charge to the Town of Plover will result in a special charge levied on the property owner's tax bill as per s. 66.60(16), Wisconsin Statutes.

This ordinance is effective upon posting by the town clerk as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
