REPLACING TOWN OF PLOVER ORDINANCE 081709 BOARD OF REVIEW APPOINTMENTS

Whereas, Sec. 70.46 authorizes that the Board of Review, may by ordinance, consist of any number of town, city or village residents, and may include public officers and public employees, and

Whereas, Sec. 70.47 (6m)(c) authorizes the appointment of alternate members to serve on the Board of Review when standing members are removed from individual cases:

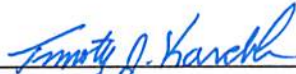
Therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Plover, Portage County, does ordain as follows:

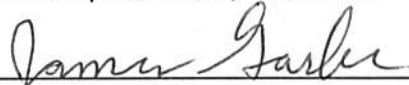
- ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE TOWN BOARD
- FOUR APPOINTED CITIZEN ELECTORS OF THE TOWNSHIP
- EIGHT APPOINTED CITIZEN ELECTORS OF THE TOWNSHIP AS ALTERNATES

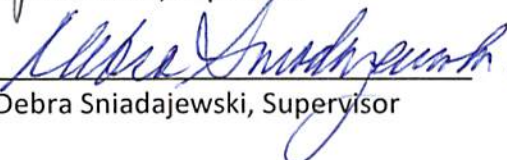
with the understanding that all citizen electors who sit in determination on the Board of Review shall receive per diem equal to the meeting per diem as prescribed in the Town of Plover Personnel Policy Handbook for committee members.

It shall be further understood that all appointments will be made by the Chairman of the Town Board at the first town board meeting following spring elections, and for any appointee agreeing to serve, a two-year term in office shall be served.

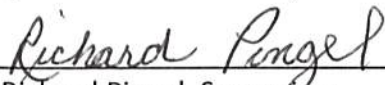

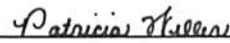
