

## PUBLIC NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS OF THE SHULLSBURG ELECTRIC UTILITY

Shullsburg Electric Utility has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin to increase electric rates. The increase is necessary to reflect changes in operating costs, capital improvements, and a need to review and adjust the rate tariff structure since the last electric rate case on February 15, 2019.

The summary of the proposed rate increases for the most common rates are as follows:

Small Power Monthly Billed Demand Charge	\$7.00 per kW	\$7.00 per kW
Small Power Energy Charge	\$ .0796 per kWh	\$ .1044 per kWh
Large Power Customer Charge	\$100.0 per month	\$100.00 per month
Large Power Distribution Demand Charge	\$1.75 per kW	\$2.25 per kW
Large Power Monthly Billed Demand Charge	\$8.00 per kW	\$8.50 per kW
Large Power Energy Charge – On Peak	\$ .0837 per kW	\$ .1042 per kW
Large Power Energy Charge – Off Peak	\$ .0662 per kW	\$ .0850per kW
