

## Town of Bloomer

### Notice of Bids Wanted for Road Work

The Town Board of the Town of Bloomer, Chippewa County, Wisconsin will be accepting bids for:

Crack filling for 2.25 miles of town roads as follows:

210<sup>th</sup> Ave east from county Hwy AA to end of black top - .50 mile

235<sup>th</sup> Ave east from county Hwy AA to end of black top – 1.25 miles

90<sup>th</sup> St. south from 225<sup>th</sup> Ave east to intersection of 230<sup>th</sup> Ave- .50 mile

For the roads proposed to be crack filled, the cracks are to be routed, cleaned, filled, squeegeed, and blotted.

Chip seal coating for 1.82 miles of town roads as follows:

102<sup>nd</sup> St from State Hwy 64 north to 200<sup>th</sup> Ave - 1 mile

130<sup>th</sup> St from state Hwy 64 north to end of black top - .82

For the roads to be chip seal coated, cracks larger than 1/4-inch are to be filled, patch localized-problem areas, sweep before applying liquid asphalt, and sweep after rolling aggregate to remove excess aggregate. Road surface must be dry before application, no rain predicted during application or setting time, humidity must be less than 75%, must specify aggregate size and asphalt application rate in the bid.

Rut overlay

83<sup>rd</sup> St - 1 mile

230<sup>th</sup> Ave for approx. 1200 FT on the north side of the road going west

The Town is requesting separate bids for each road segment for the proposed crack filling, chip sealing and rut overlaying projects for budgeting purposes.

Bids need to be submitted in a sealed envelope labeled “Crack Fill Bid”, “Chip Seal Bid” and “Rut Overlay Bid” to Town Chairman, Gary Nehring, 13841 235<sup>th</sup> Ave Bloomer, WI 54724, and will be accepted until 2 p.m. June 24th at this address and will also be accepted at 7:30 P.M. at the beginning of a special Town of Bloomer board meeting to be held on June 24, 2013 at the Bloomer Town Hall, located at 21281 State Highway 40, Bloomer, WI when the bids will be opened.
