Unfinished Business

- **Lake management plan**
 - Asking for input on the plan last year. Have not yet received any feedback. There will be a workshop on June 13th with the Lake Alliance to help with Lake Management Plan writing.
- **Harvesting**
 - Are considered an essential business and will be available for harvesting when needed.
- **Grant**
 - Did not receive the grant. Some feedback that grant was too narrow and some concern about lack of lake management plan.
 - Those who advised thought it would be worthwhile to consider reapplying moving forward.
 - May 1 deadline to express interest. Sep 2 deadline for formally express intent. Nov 1 deadline for grant application. Max grant is \$25k.
 - Pegler will move forward with May 1st deadline to submit interest in applying again.
- **Buoys**
 - Around \$200 each. Will order 4 or 5 new ones.

- **Website migration**
 - Meeting set up for April 24th to begin discussing the process.
- **Discuss/act on teleconferencing options**
 - Will be exploring options for Board as well as public participation and will discuss during July meeting.

New Business

- **Tax levy language**
 - Donner drafted language explaining increase in this year's PLMD levy. Will share updated language with Board for their review before sending to the Clerk.
- **Vandalism at boat landing and lake signs**
 - Town has secured materials to reinforce and will be installing shortly.
 - Security lighting and have moved closer to road.
 - Town of Jackson will be keeping all boat launches open.
- **COVID-19 Impact**
 - Barley bags have not been picked up.
 - Harvesting can move forward.
 - Boat launch to remain open.
 - Link to travel advisor provided on Lake District website and in communications.
