Advisory to Seasonal and Second Homeowners

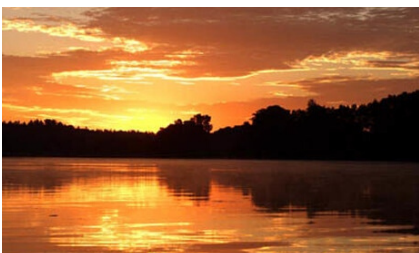
Due to high community spread of COVID-19 in certain areas of Wisconsin and the United States, Adams County is recommending that you stay at your permanent home if you have a seasonal or second home in Adams County.

If you are already back in Adams County, you must immediately self-quarantine for 14 days. This means stay in your home, only leaving to go seek medical treatment (call first!) or prescriptions or to go to the grocery store.

Due to our very limited healthcare infrastructure, please do not visit us now. Stay at your permanent home.

Adams County has one of the highest populations of older adults in Wisconsin. This population is at the highest risk of COVID-19. Keeping our seniors safe is very important.
