Proposed Amendment to Our Municipal Charter

Section 6.03 (b)

The nomination petition for any one candidate shall be assembled and united into one petition and filed with the city clerk not *later than 12:00 noon, 60 days prior to the election.* carlier than 60 days before the election and later than 12:00 Noon, 45 days prior to the election. No nomination shall be valid unless at the time of the filing of the nomination petition the candidate shall file with the city clerk in writing his or her consent under oath accepting the nomination. The candidate need sign the consent on only one nomination petition.

Section 6.04 (a)

Names. The name and residence of each candidate shall be given. On a date to be designated by the city clerk but no later than 40 days and no earlier than 42 days prior to the election, the city clerk shall determine, by lot, the order that said candidates' names shall appear on the ballot; provided the proceedings shall be public and the candidates shall be given an opportunity to be present.
