The same were received, sorted, counted and declared in open meeting, by the Warden who presided and in the presence of the Ward Clerk, who formed a list of the candidates and referendum questions voted for and against and made records thereof in the presence of the Warden in open meeting sealed up the copies of said records as appears by copies of said lists, duly attested by the Warden and Ward Clerk, and returned to the City Clerk of said Calais on the 4th day of November, 2025, the same being within twenty-four hours of said meeting.

Shall the County Commissioners be authorized to issue general obligation securities of the County in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$11,000,000 to provide a source of funds to be drawn as needed to cover budgetary shortfalls and emergency expenses as they may occur from time to time in any fiscal year, as determined by the County Commissioners in their discretion, including the authority and discretion to fix the dates, maturities, interest rates, denominations, calls for redemption (with or without premium), form, and other details of said securities, and including authority to execute and deliver the securities on behalf of the County?
