Administrator Update: We are accepting Lifeguard and Pool Manager applications- if you or anyone you know is interested in working with the City pool, contact City Hall for application instructions. This isn't an April Fool's joke - if we don't get enough lifeguards, the summer pool hours could be affected!

**Police Spotlight:** Officer Winch has been in contact with the DNR and the Cub Scouts for the upcoming boating season and the life preserver display should be completed once the remaining items arrive. Officer Winch has also attended further education on interviewing younger victims of sexual assault that she's already put to use. Officer Kucinsky is wrapping up the winter parking citations, he also sent out numerous letters for people not having numbers on the residence and has also started to look at other ordinance violations now that the snow is melting. The Police Department is working currently with the Sheriff Department in getting a program up and running that would assist us in locating individuals with special needs faster, this program is called Project lifesaver. This program was brought up during the last search and rescue, which included numerous agencies, blood hound dogs, and the use of our drone in locating a 17-year-old with special needs. The individual was located after 6 ½ hours of searching, however this program is geared for these type of instances which would cut this time drastically down.
