Police Spotlight: The Hillsboro Police Department has had a busy few months to start the year. Since the beginning of the year, we have executed two narcotics search warrants within city limits. With the temperature starting to warm up, we will begin focusing again on ordinance violations in individuals yards and property. The Police Department is asking for everyone's cooperation in making sure that everyone is picking up stuff that may have accumulated under the snow that will hopefully be melting soon. A reminder to make sure that if you have a dog that you are picking up after the dog, please. This is especially true again as the snow is melting, as we have been getting a lot of complaints about this in the last month. HPD will be participating in a drug take back for all unused prescription medication on 04/30/2022 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., however we do have a drug take back box outside of the Police Department in the hallway that is accessible Monday through Friday from 8 AM to 4:30 PM.
