Police Spotlight: For the month of May, the Hillsboro Police Department handled 255 calls for service. Of those 255, 29 were traffic stops, 10 ordinance violations, 6 disorderly conducts, and 5 motor vehicle crashes with 1 containing injuries. Officer Nachtigal spent a week up in Green Bay taking in a training hosted by the Wisconsin Department of Justice. The skills and knowledge Officer Nachtigal returned to Hillsboro with are highly specialized, as the training provided her the roadmap on how to conduct successful sensitive crimes interviews. The



officers of the Hillsboro Police Department recognize how challenging of a training it was and appreciate Officer Nachtigal's dedication to our department, the residents we serve, and continuing to be the definition of a consummate professional.
