Dates to Remember

2nd and 4th Mondays Each Month – Town Board meets at 6:30pm in most cases except when the Portage County Unit of the Wisconsin Towns Association meets the same night. April to October – According to the DNR, avoid cutting or wounding oaks from April to October to prevent oak wilt. Insects that carry the fungus are *most active April* 15th to August 15th. June 1st to December 31st – Burning Permits are **not** required in Portage County but you must still check the restrictions on the day of the burn by calling 1-888-WIS-BURN or at <u>www.dnr.wi.gov/wisburn</u>. Call the Sheriff's Office at (715) 346-1400 at start and end of burn to reduce false alarms.

July 11th & July 18th – Volunteers are needed to help with clean up and rock picking at the newly named Town of Stockton Park from 8:00 -11:30am. If you're unable to help out during the event, please contact Jerry Piesik (715-498-4417) for instructions on what you can do on your own. We're looking forward to making the park a great place for all! July 29th – Assessment Roll for the 2015 property tax year will be open for examination from 3-5pm at the Town Hall. Information about the assessment, how to file an objection, and Board of Review procedures will be made available at that time. July 29th – Board of Review convenes to consider objections to assessments. 5pm to 7pm at the Town Hall.

July 31st – 2nd Installment of Property Taxes are due to the Portage County Treasurer. August 1st – Arnott Lions Car and Truck Show at the Arnott Lions Park. Stockton Fire Department will also have equipment on display.

Frequently Asked Questions

The Garbage Truck Broke My Cart... Please contact Advanced Disposal at (888) 271-7176 and they will deliver a replacement in 7 to 10 days. When do I need a Building Permit? A Town Building Permit is required for any additions, alterations or remodeling of a dwelling or any part attached to, or less than 5' from, a dwelling. Exempt: Minor repairs, door & window replacement of the same size units or reroofing where no structural alterations are involved, replacement of furnace or water heater provided the venting and fuel type remain the same, and detached accessory structures more than 5' from the dwelling. Call Building Inspector Mike Bembenek at (715) 570-8378. A Portage County Zoning Permit, (715) 346-1334, is also required for all new structures and all additions that increase the footprint or volume of the structure.

For EMS inquiries, please contact the Town Clerk for more information. Where Can I Take Yard Waste? Zblewski Bros. LLC in Plover (715) 341-5350 is the only outlet we know of. The fee is \$5 to \$25/load and they may *discontinue the service at any time. The* Town no longer accepts yard waste due to abuse. Dumping in the ditch/right-ofway is illegal. Please consider composting.

How Can I Adopt a Road?
