

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
TOWN OF STOCKTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN/FUTURE  
LAND USE MAP AND ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Town Board of the Town of Stockton, Portage County, Wisconsin, will be holding a Public Hearing on a proposed amendment to its Comprehensive Plan/Future Land Use Map on December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 6:30 pm at the Town of Stockton Town Hall, 7252 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Custer, WI, 54423.

The Town of Stockton Plan Commission met November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to amend the Town of Stockton Comprehensive Plan to consider a change to the land use designation on Future Land Use Map 8.3 for Parcel # 034-23-0931:08.09 (Approximately 2.2 acres total) L1 Enterprise to Commercial. The Plan Commission will forward their approval recommendation to the Town Board.

This change in land use designation is necessary to allow for the property owner to request a rezoning of the parcel #034-23-0931:08.09 to operate a mini warehousing from an old potato warehouse on the above reference parcel. The Stockton Plan Commission also approved this request and will forward their approval recommendation to the Stockton Town Board. All Plan Commission recommendations will be on the agenda of the Stockton Town Board meeting on Wednesday, December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
