

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Town of Stockton Comprehensive Plan/Future
Land use Map and Zoning ordinance Amendment

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town Board of the Town of Stockton, Portage County, Wisconsin, will be holding a Public Hearing on a proposed amendment to its Comprehensive Plan/Future Land Use Map on December 14, 2020 at 6:30PM at the Town of Stockton Town Hall, 7252 6th Street, Custer, WI, 54423.

The Town of Stockton Plan Commission met October 7th, 2020 to amend the Town of Stockton Comprehensive Plan to consider a change to the land use designation on Future Land Use Map 8.3 for Parcel #034-24-0932-10.06 (Approximately 14.6 acres total) Residential to Commercial. The Plan Commission will forward their approval recommendation to the Town Board.

This change in land use designation is necessary to allow for the property owner to request a rezoning of the (Approximately 14.6 acres total) of parcel #034-24-0932-10.06 from A-3 to C4 to operate an office/truck terminal. The Stockton Plan Commission also approved this request and will forward their approval recommendation to the Stockton Town Board. All Plan Commission recommendations will be on the agenda of the Stockton Town Board meeting on Monday, December 14th, 2020.
