

ORDINANCE #25-04

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND RECREATE SECTION § 492-9 E. OF THE  
VILLAGE OF FREMONT MUNICIPAL CODE

The Village Board of the Village of Fremont, WI hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 492-9 E of the Village of Fremont Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**E. Snowmobile and ATV routes established.**

**(1)**

The Village reserves the right to close or modify routes and trails at any time. Any restrictions of trails and routes shall be designated by simple motion and by simple majority by the Village Board and shall be marked accordingly.

**(2)**

All snowmobile/ATV/UTV routes and trails should be signed in accordance with NR 64.12, and NR 64.12(7)(c).

**(3)**

All Village streets and transportation marked corridors within the Village are hereby designated as snowmobile/ATV/UTV routes. Authorized private lands subject to public easement or leases are designated trails.

**(4)**

Under Wis. Stat. 23.33(4)(d) 3.b. and 11(am)3., the Village of Fremont authorizes the operation of ATVs/UTVs on STH 110 between CTH H south and CTH H north to cross the bridge over the Wolf River. In addition, ATV/UTV operators must comply with the following:


- a. Cross the bridge in the most direct manner practicable and at a place where no obstruction prevents a quick and safe crossing.
- b. Stay as far to the right of the roadway or shoulder as practicable.
- c. Stop the vehicle prior to the crossing.
- d. Yield the right-of-way to other vehicles, pedestrians, electric scooters, and electric personal assistive mobility devices using the roadway or shoulder.
- e. Exit the highway as quickly and safely as practicable after crossing the bridge.

Section E (4) shall not be in effect unless Waupaca County enacts a similar ordinance for this segment of STH 110 to cross the bridge over the Wolf River.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as required by law.
