VOTER REGISTRATION

If you have moved, changed your name, turned 18 years of age, or are a new resident of Wisconsin, you will need to register or re-register to vote. To register to vote in the Village of Fremont, you must have resided in the township for at least 28 consecutive days prior to an election. You can register online at: https://myvote.wi.gov or print the Voter Registration Form and bring to the clerk's office with proof of residency.

In-person Voting – Photo I.D. is required.

Absentee Ballot Request – Permanent

If you are indefinitely confined because of age, illness, infirmity, or disability, you can receive an absentee ballot on a permanent bases. Visit https://myvote.wi.gov for more information.

Absentee Ballot Request
