WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The Village of Ontonagon Winter Parking Restrictions is now in effect. Vehicles parked on Village streets between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. are in violation and shall be subject to citation. During winter parking restrictions no vehicles shall be parked within six feet of the plowed right-of-way or shoulder of the road between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. Vehicles parked on the street or right-of-way that hindering snow removal will be towed away at the expense of the owner. This ordinance will be strictly enforced from October 15th to April 15th.

WINTER SNOW PLOWING & REMOVAL

It is unlawful to plow snow across or deposit snow on any road way or plow snow in a manner that obstructs the safety vision of a driver of a motor vehicle.

It is the owner's responsibility to clear snow and maintain access to their curbside mailbox. The Village will not be responsible for any damages to a mail box that is not clear of snow or clearly marked.

ADOPT A FIRE HYDRANT

It's important to remember that by keeping the fire hydrant by your home clear of snow and accessible, you're helping yourself. Seconds count when there is a fire. We have an all-Volunteer Fire Department. They don't get paid to save lives and fight fires, in the dead of winter, the dark of the night or any other time of day. By keeping a fire hydrant clear of snow, you make the Volunteer's job easier and the house you save may be yours.
