2020-2025 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, Ontonagon County and its communities are at risk of natural, technological, and societal hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires communities to have a five-year Hazard Mitigation Plan approved by FEMA in order to receive funds available through certain mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the Ontonagon County Hazard Mitigation Plan prepared by the Western Upper Peninsula Planning and Development Region, in cooperation with the Ontonagon County Office of Emergency Management, identifies the hazard threats to the County and feasible mitigation projects to minimize hazard impacts; and

WHEREAS, the contents of the Hazard Mitigation Plan were reviewed by and account for input from residents and local officials representing the local units of government with Ontonagon County;


