

**VILLAGE OF ONTONAGON  
RESOLUTION NO. 2023 – 15  
In support of the extension of the MiTrale ORV/Snowmobile trail  
within the Village Boundaries**

At a meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Ontonagon, held on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 2023, in the offices at 315 Quartz Street, Ontonagon, Michigan, the following resolution was offered by Trustee Seid and supported by Trustee Chastan.

**RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Ontonagon and MiTrale are in agreement that the current designated MiTrale ORV multi-use route should be extended to the Village's Lakeshore Park and will provide access to the proposed electric vehicle charging station to be located on Village property, and

WHEREAS, the Village has entered into a Leasing agreement with Polaris Industries to locate and operate an electric vehicle charging station within the village, and

WHEREAS, the Village supports the extension of the route designation for development purposes, and

WHEREAS, the extension is consistent with and supports the Village's state approved five-year Recreation Plan


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village council approves the extension of the ORV route.
