Francis Frontier Days will feature a Rodeo and Bull Wars. For the younger cowboys & cowgirls, a junior rodeo, kids scramble, horse games, bounce house, live music and much more.

The Arts & Crafts Fair will feature a selection of original and hand-crafted goods. Visitors will be able to shop for local specialty items. The hours of the Arts & Crafts Fair are Saturday 9:00 am to 6:00 pm and Monday 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.

Enclosed with this letter is a vendor application and electrical request form. Tent spaces will be assigned based on electrical requirements and the types of goods for sale. As this is a City-sponsored event, we will do our best to space similar items apart from one another and be as fair as possible.

Applications and fees must be received no later than Thursday, August 24th, 2023.

Vendors must supply their own tables, chairs, displays, etc. Francis Frontier Days is a rain or shine event; please come prepared for inclement weather. Francis Frontier Days will not be held responsible for any lost or stolen items, so please provide the proper security for your items.

Each business owner is responsible for reporting and submitting their collective sales tax to the State. You will receive a "Welcome" packet when you check-in Saturday morning, September 2nd, 2023.
