Francis Frontier Days began with a simple idea—a place for local cowboys, farmers, and the 4-H Club to gather, ride, share stories, and enjoy each other's company. Driven by this vision, the local 4-H Club organized several fundraisers to help build the arena we still use today. With additional support from town grants and generous community volunteers who donated time, materials, and labor, the chutes were built and the arena came to life.

Once complete, the community hosted lively events like wild cow milking, team roping, and fun games for the kids. In 1983, the Town of Francis declared that Labor Day would become a day of annual celebration. From those humble beginnings, the small town of Francis has grown into the City of Francis—and so has the celebration.

What started as a single-day event has now become a four-day festival. As the city has evolved, so have the traditions and activities of Francis Frontier Days. Today, the event features something for everyone: junior rodeos, kids' scrambles, horse games, concerts, vendor booths, concessions, skydiving exhibitions, a movie in the park, and a top-tier rodeo sanctioned by the Rocky Mountain Professional Rodeo Association.

Now celebrating its 41st year, Francis Frontier Days continues to honor our Western roots and community spirit. It's a family-friendly event packed with fun, excitement, and a heartfelt tribute to the heritage that built Francis.
