Fire Department - Josh Winter

On the Nevis Fire and Rescue Department, we have 19 active members. We respond to both fire and medical calls in our coverage area. All our members are Fire 1 and 2 certified as well as Emergency Medical Responder.

We serve the townships of Crow Wing, Nevis, Mantrap, and Thorpe. We also have a county wide mutual aid agreement with all departments as well as one with Menahga Fire Department. For wildland fires we also have an agreement with DNR forestry.

Last year we responded to 104 medical calls and 55 fire calls.

I officially became chief of Nevis Fire and Rescue in January of 2023. Before that I was interim chief since May 2022.

My goals as chief are to grow the department and to keep the department up to date with current tools and equipment. Recently, we purchased a battery powered ventilation fan, which is lighter and easier to operate than a gas fan.

In the future, I will be looking into grants to update some of our trucks. I want our department to be able to provide the best services that we can in our small rural community.

We are always looking for new members to join our department. If you are interested stop by Nevis city hall for an application or talk to any Nevis fireperson.
