## ORDINANCE # 27 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #25 REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Nevis did adopt an ordinance licensing and regulating the sale and consumption of intoxicating liquor on January 12,1993, and

WHEREAS, the intent of the City Council of the City of Nevis in granting "on-sale" licenses to restaurants is to encourage the restaurant industry within the City of Nevis, the sale of intoxicating liquor being incidental to the restaurant operation, the sale of meals not being incidental to the sale of liquor by the drink.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Nevis adds the following subdivision to Section 2 of Ordinance # 25.

Section 2, Subdivision 8. Restaurants. "Kitchen facilities open" and "in conjunction with the sale of food" shall have the following meaning and be subject to the following limitations/ interpretations when used in this ordinance:

- a) "Restaurant" is a place of business where meals can be bought and eaten and which derives the major portion of its gross sales on a calendar year basis from the sale of such meals.
- b) Licensee may not post hours for a restaurant facility which are different from those hours of operation for the serving of "on sale" beverages.

Effective date: This amendment becomes effective upon its passage and publication. according to law.
