## ORDINANCE NO.9

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRESPASS AND OTHER CONDUCT IN SCHOOLS AND OTHER PUBLIC BUILDINGS AND THE PRESCRIBED PENALTIES THEREFOR

The Village Council of Nevis, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Trespass. It shall be unlawful for any person to remain in a public building, private school building, or public school building, or upon the grounds and office thereof, after being requested to leave the premises by such persons lawfully responsible for the control of said premises.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person whether on or off said premises willfully to annoy, disturb, interfere with, or obstruct any classroom instruction teaching program or any other assembly being conducted upon the foresaid premises.

Section 3. Any violation of the provisions of the Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof the offender may be imprisoned for not more than 90 days or may be fined not more than \$300.00 or both.

<u>Section 4.</u> The full force and effect of this Ordinance shall date from and after its approval, adoption and publication, according to law.
