The Minnesota Legislature passed a law that amends Minnesota Statute 144.3831 to increase the safe drinking water service connection fee. Effective January 1, 2026 the new fee will be \$1.27.

All customers are allowed 3,333 gallons of water per month with their minimum charge. The cost currently is \$3.82 per 1,000 gallons over the allowed amount. January 1, 2026 the new cost will be \$4.82 per 1,000 gallons over the allowed amount.
