ORDINANCE NO. 18 SNOW REMOVAL

Revised January 13, 2020

The City Council of the City of Nevis ordains as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> On any day when snow accumulation is 3 inches or more no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on all city streets between the hours of two o'clock A.M. and eight o'clock A.M.

<u>Section 2.</u> Exceptions – Police cars, hearses, ambulances, and fire department vehicles responding to an emergency call. Vehicles called out for emergency repairs to electric light and power lines, telephone lines and water systems.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Hubbard County Sheriff's Department is hereby authorized to remove such vehicles from the street. Storage charges are to be paid by the owner of such vehicle.

<u>Section 4.</u> Driveways – When plowing a City Street, Public Works will try their hardest to minimize the amount of snow deposited in driveways, but sometimes this is inevitable. MN Statute 160.2715(a)(1) expressly forbids obstructing any highway or depositing snow or ice therein. A violation of 160.2715 is a misdemeanor and as such is punishable by up to ninety days in jail and a fine of up to \$1000.00 (the maximum possible punishment for a misdemeanor).

Section 5. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
