# CITY OF NEVIS ORDINANCE NO. 52

# AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF TEMPORARY DWELLINGS WITHIN THE NEVIS CITY LIMITS

The City Council of the City of Nevis, Hubbard County, Minnesota hereby ordains:

#### **Section 1:** Definition

A Temporary Dwelling is defined as a structure erected or set upon a parcel of property, within the Residential Zoning District, for a set amount of time.

## **Section 2:** Types of dwelling places:

- A) Travel trailer, motor home coaches and fish houses, placed on a parcel to be used as a cabin, not to exceed six (6) months, then removed from property.
  - -A permit must be obtained from the City Office.
  - -The property owner must hook up to the city water and sewer system. (see City Ordinance #23, #30, #28)
  - -A monthly fee (current year charges) will apply, along with a \$75.00 connection fee, and a \$75.00 shut off fee.
  - -RV must be hooked up to Minnesota Power Electric.
  - -No accessory structures will be allowed without a permanent structure in place. (Zoning Ordinance #36)
- B) Temporary residence in a basement or foundation structure while awaiting the completion of the total structure may be allowed for a period not to exceed six (6) months.
  - -A temporary occupancy permit must be signed off by the City Building Official. (the dwelling must meet the Minnesota Building Code)
  - -The property owner must hook up to the city water and sewer system. (see City Ordinance #23, #30, #28)
  - -A monthly fee (current year charges) will apply, along with connection fees according to our Water and Sewer Ordinances.
  - -The structure must be hooked up to Minnesota Power Electric.

### **Section 3:** Violations.

Any violation of this ordinance, or failure to comply with any of its requirements, shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable as defined by law.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
