As your city council Fire Department Commissioner, I want to spotlight the vital work of the **Nevis On-Call Fire Department**. Our local first responders keep our families safe through dedicated emergency care and proactive infrastructure planning. Here are your latest fire department updates for 2026:

- **Chief Nicklason Re-elected:** The council unanimously voted to retain **Brent Nicklason as Fire Chief** for another two-year term. Under his leadership, the department has successfully updated emergency vehicles, applied for crucial gear grants, and maintained rigorous training.
- **Facility & Capital Planning:** Our long-term planning moves forward as the city reviews a **30-year capital improvement plan**. This initiative includes evaluating a future site for a new fire hall to ensure long-term functionality.
- **Community Hero Support:** Our firefighters remain highly active, managing dozens of local medical and auto calls each quarter while supporting community favorites like the annual Nevis Lions' Easter egg hunt.
