Hello, neighbors! We are certainly in construction mode throughout the city! It's going to be a summer-long project filled with dust and disruption, but the end-result will be amazing for our community. Unfortunately, we have had a few instances of people mistreating the workers and violating safe driving cautions, which prompted the stern notice from SEH. Thankfully, the situation has now much improved. I appreciate everyone's patience, grace, and support as the incredible teams at Veit and SEH continue their work. We are implementing a 15 MPH speed limit for the duration of the project to assist with traffic calming and dust control. Please, slow down, be nice, be careful, and plan for delays.

KEY UPDATES

New Website: Councilmember Hovey has done outstanding work in re-creating our city website using a new technology platform from Town Web. The updated site looks fantastic and provides an integrated feature for distributing citywide email updates. We have transferred all email addresses from the distribution list previously maintained by former Mayor Mary Ann Young. Planning for Household Water Connections: We are very pleased that many households want to connect to city water, and we're making efforts to do this as a bundled project. This approach will provide homeowners with a competitive bid price and project oversight by the city's engineering team. We are also researching the potential to offer financing that would allow for a multi-year payment plan, conveniently incorporated into your property tax.
